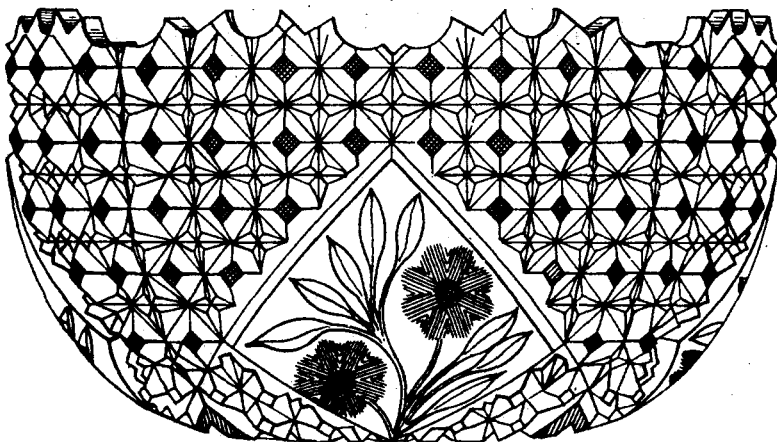
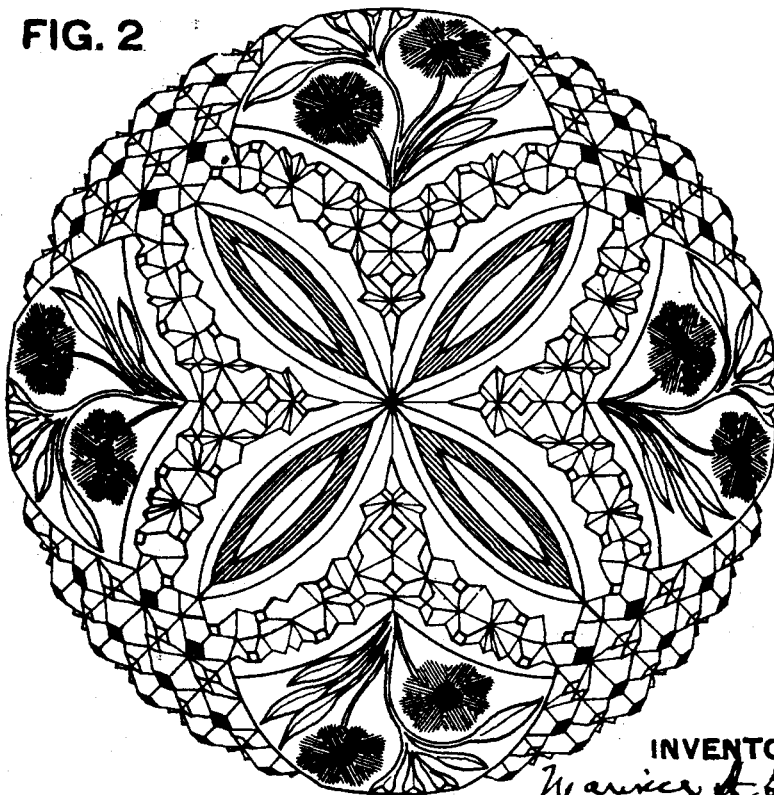

Be it known that I, MAURICE A. SMITH, a citizen of the United States, and residing at Jeannette, in the county of Westmoreland, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Glass Bowl, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
